\*<u>This link</u> will allow parents to sign up to receive updates via email regarding their child's school portraits. **Birthdays** – Invitations to birthday parties need to be sent to a students' homes or delivered to students outside of the school day. Students must go home prior to going to a birthday party. Leaving from school creates a feeling of being left out by students not invited.

## FROM THE HEALTH OFFICE

### Immunizations:

A reminder that Minnesota state statute requires that all students enrolled in grades K-12 be immunized according to state guidelines or have an exemption (medical or non-medical/ conscientious objection). If your child is not compliant, you have already received notification from the health office to let you know. There are resources accessible this month for families who are uninsured/ underinsured or are struggling to pay for

immunizations. The school nurse can assist in accessing these resources, if this is the case, and can be reached at 952-401-6905.

The flu vaccine can reduce the risk of severe flu-related illness by 40-60%. Everyone ages 6 months and older is typically eligible. The best time to get immunized is in the fall, ideally by the end of October.

# COVID:

The Deephaven Health Office has at-home tests available; please reach out directly to us if you would like some to use now or have on hand. The expiration dates have been extended by the manufacturer, so they are good through the end of the year.

The MN Department of Health has partnered with Cue Health for a free telehealth test-to-treat program to help ensure Minnesotans have easy access to care, treatment and COVID-19 medication delivery.
