Absence Requests - Skyward

There are two ways to enter an absence request:

1. Call the attendance line at 952-287-8127
2. Enter Request in Skyward (see directions below)

If you know of a future absence for your student(s), you can complete and absence request in Skyward by following the steps below:

1. Go to Skyward and click on Attendance from the left column.
 2. From Attendance, click on Enter Absent Request.
 3. From here, each of your children will be listed. Click on Add Request for the child you are entering and absence for.
 4. Enter Start Date-Time, End Date- Time and the Reason and optional Comments.
