

Two kinds of aid

Merit based

- From schools
- From non-school resources

Need based

- From schools
- From Federal/state resources

Merit-based scholarships

Based on

- Academic achievement
- Talent (music, theater)
- Service
- Athletics
- Other wonderfulness

Offered by

- Colleges/universities
- Other organizations
 - Companies
 - Congregations
 - Civic organizations

Merit-based scholarships

College/University

- Check admissions for instructions and deadlines
- Could require special essay or audition

Other sources

- Deadlines vary
- Probably require special application

- For need-based aid, file the FAFSA to determine the EFC
- If necessary, file the CSS Profile
- Research scholarship opportunities at your colleges
- Use the scholarship search in Naviance
- Use another scholarship search engine (Going Merry, Big Future, Finaid.org)

Where do we go from here?

- Have “the talk” about college costs and affordability with your parents.
